ASPECT	MODERN ASSESSMENT TASKS	FUTURE ASSESSMENT TASKS
Objective	Measure knowledge acquisition and retention	Assess application of knowledge, skill development, and holistic growth
Format	Standardised tests, multiple-choice questions	Dynamic assessments, interactive projects, real-world problem solving
Feedback	Grades and rankings after completion	Continuous, adaptive feedback to guide learning journeys
Skills Focus	Recall, rote memorisation, specific academic skills	Critical thinking, creativity, collaboration, digital literacy
Tools	Paper-based tests, occasional computer-based testing	AI-enhanced tools, virtual simulations, e-portfolios
Personalisation	One-size-fits-all approach	Tailored to individual learner's pace, style, and interests
Assessment Role	Summative evaluation at end of a learning period	Formative, ongoing assessment throughout the learning process
Data Use	Comparative performance metrics	In-depth analytics for personalized learning insights
Inclusivity	Often biased towards certain learning styles	Designed to be accessible and fair to diverse learners
